

Dear Client,

pursuant to Art. 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data – general regulation on the protection of personal data (Dz. U. [Journal of Laws] EU L 119/1 of 4th May 2016), Zdrofit kindly informs that:

- 1) Zdrofit spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością with its registered office in Warsaw at the following address: ul. Mangalia 4, 02-758 Warszawa (hereinafter referred to as We) is the Administrator of your personal data.
  - 2) We have appointed personal data protection officer who supervises correctness of personal data processing and whom you may contact under the following e-mail address: [iodo@zdrofit.pl](mailto:iodo@zdrofit.pl).
  - 3) We may process your personal data for the following purposes:
    - to prepare an agreement to be concluded by you and us;
    - to execute the agreement we concluded with you;
    - to enable you to use our services;
    - to settle your payments registered by our customer service system;
    - to enable you to sign up for fitness classes.
  - 4) The data we process is:
    - for short-term memberships (Active Senior, Student/Pupil 28 days OPEN, Pool for Children): name and surname, e-mail address, phone number;
    - for agreements (OPEN 12 Months, OPEN without limitation, Student/Pupil OPEN without limitation membership): name and surname, mailing address, e-mail address, phone number;
    - for external partners' cards (Multisport and FitProfit), if you use the Member's Zone: name and surname and e-mail address;
    - for one-off entry: name and surname, e-mail address, phone number.
- In order to simplify the procedure of entry to the club related to the identification of a Client, we will save a photograph of you with your voluntary consent. Lack of this consent means that you will have to present a document confirming your identity every time while entering Zdrofit's club.
- In all enlisted cases, we will still process PESEL numbers and photographs which have been saved in our Client Database until now – in accordance with given consents.
- 5) Your data can be accessed by companies that help us in providing our services for you, as well as companies maintaining our IT systems;
  - 6) You provide your data voluntarily; however, it is important to notice that the refusal to provide it makes it impossible for you to use our services;
  - 7) You have a right to access and correct your data;
  - 8) You have a right to transfer your data;
  - 9) You have a right to file a complaint to President of the Protection of Personal Data Office if you consider processing your personal data as breaching the law.
